3. The Context:

Debating Competition is organized on current and challenging contemporary issues. Inter college debating Competition affiliated colleges of three universities a) Dr. B.A.M.U. Aurangabad b) S.R.T. University Nanded c) Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar University Solapur.

4. The Practice:

This practice is helpful for college students in participative learning. Debating Competition activity is useful to create awareness among students about political, social, educational and economical issues that Indian society is facing.

- a) Our college organizes Debating Competition every year for last 24 years. The event was organized on 16/02/2023.

- b) This practice enables them to appear on the stage and express their views and opinion regarding Political, Social and Economic problems of the society and nation.

To promote students, staff and people around the college campus to participate in general health check-up by District Civil Hospital and Terna Speciality Hospital and Research Centre, Nerul, New Mumbai.

To distribute required medicine after health check-up to students and peoples in the village.

3. Context:

Covid-19 pandemic taught the lesson about health issues and it is necessary periodic health check-up to avoid serious disease and early treatment.

4. The Practice:

This practice is helpful for eradicating serious health disease and also is helpful to boost immunity of the people to counter the various disease in early stage.

5. Evidence of Success:

Two health check-up Camp were organised by NSS department. First camp was organised on 08/09/2022 in college campus for students and people in the Osmanabad city by Terna Speciality Hospital and Research Centre, Nerul, New Mumbai. The team consists of Cardiologist, ENT Specialist, Gynaecologist, Dentist, Orthopaedic Surgeon and Paediatrician. 508 people participated in the camp. After health check-up the patients having serious diseases were referred to Terna Speciality Hospital and Research Centre, Nerul, New Mumbai and Second camp was organised on 16/01/2023 by NSS department in association with Civil hospital Osmanabad at Jawala village. 207 people and students participated in the camp. Required medicines were provided to the needy patients.

6) Problem encountered and resources required:

People are unable to bear the expenditure for serious disease and not aware about their health issues. So such health check-up camps are necessary. Awareness campaign arranged through media. Expenditure of this camp was borned by Terna Public Charitable Trust.
